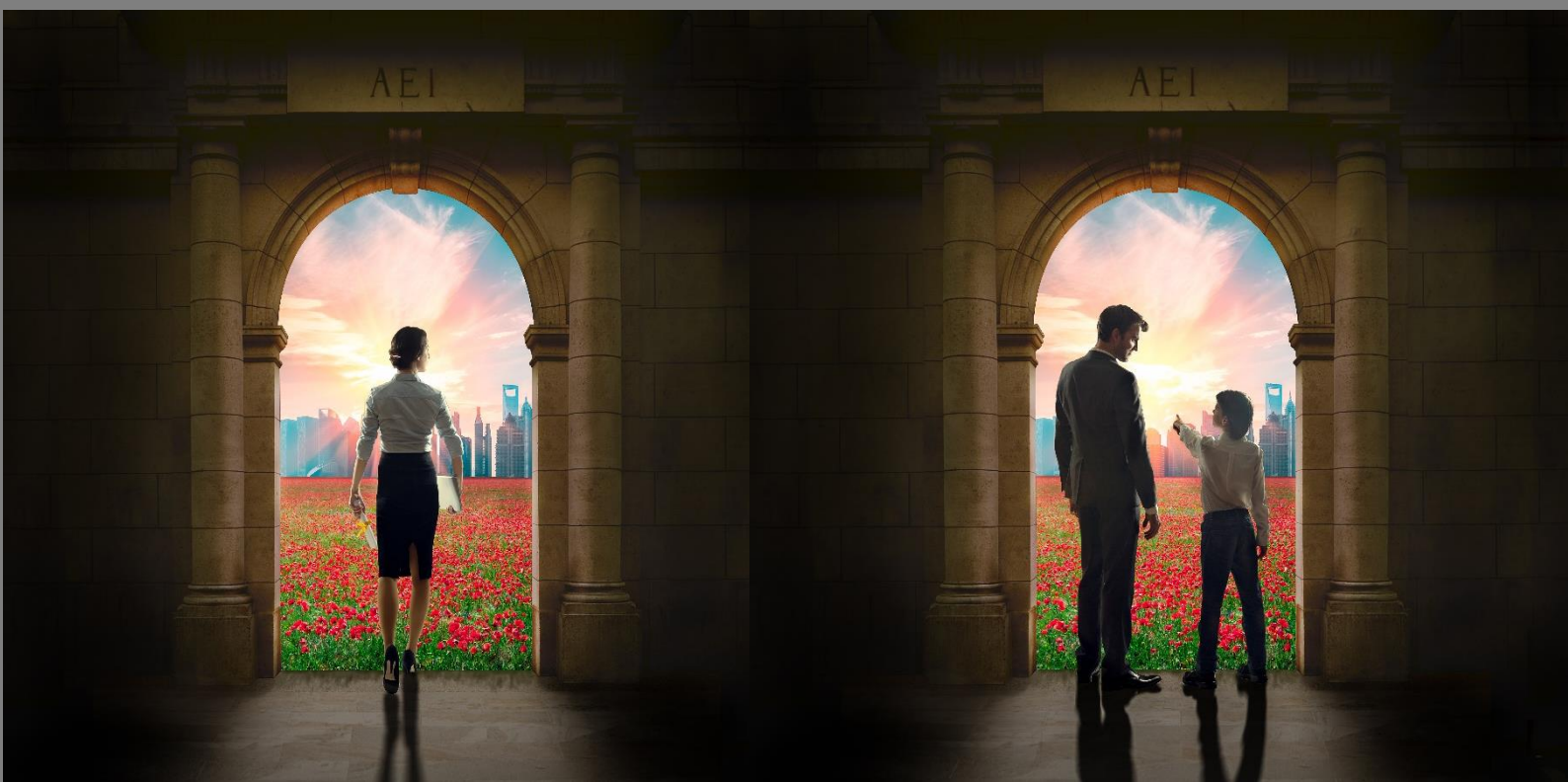

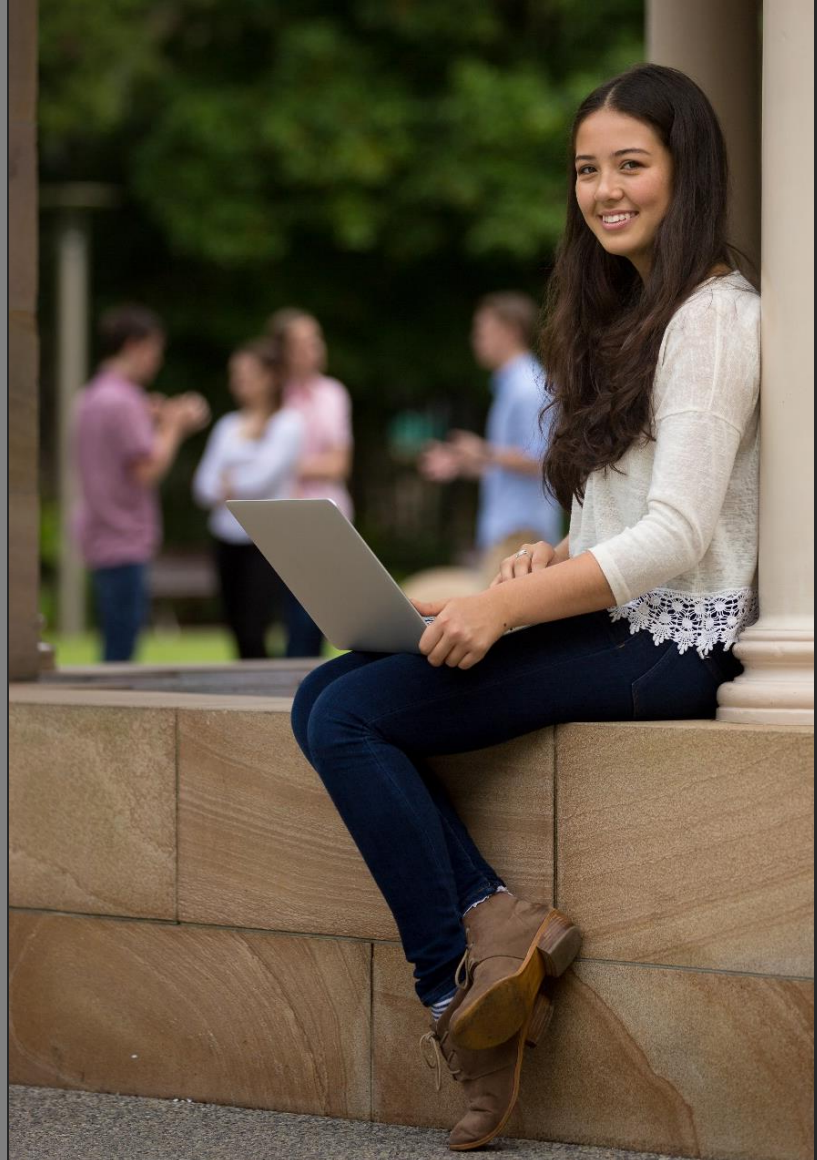

POSITION OVERVIEW

Running alongside its 'Dare To Be Brilliant!' Campaign inspiring students to excel, Alpert Enterprises International provides opportunities for students and professionals to achieve and demonstrate excellence through workshops, competitions, awards, conferences and events.

CONTRACT DETAILS

- Temporary/Contract position
- Length of one ASPIRE School Holiday Workshop period, renewable for the remaining 2017 school holidays by agreement
- Hourly Rate: \$50 per hour

KEY DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES

- Plan a three day workshop for chosen year levels, which demonstrates curriculum knowledge, creativity and innovative pedagogical strategies
- Submit a detailed workshop proposal (including workshop summary for marketing purposes)
- Undertake a complementary two hour Professional Development session on working with highly motivated or high ability students, organized by Alpert Enterprises International
- Submit planning materials and workshop materials in a timely manner in order to allow for organisation of logistics by Alpert Enterprises International
- Demonstrate collaborative work practices
- Deliver an exciting, challenging and high quality workshop for chosen age group in specified subject area
- Supervise students on the final day of AEI's ASPIRE Workshops, when students will undertake a Future Problem Solving workshop and sessions on metacognitive strategies

SELECTION CRITERIA

1. Registration with the Queensland College of Teachers
2. Possession of a current Blue Card or Exemption Card (QCT Registered Teachers only)
3. Dedication to cultivating and celebrating excellence or experience with excellence programs
4. Innovation and creativity in pedagogical practices (teaching and learning strategies)
5. Strong knowledge of curriculum in your subject area(s)
6. Experience with teaching upper primary (Year 5-6) and/or middle school (Year 7-10) students
