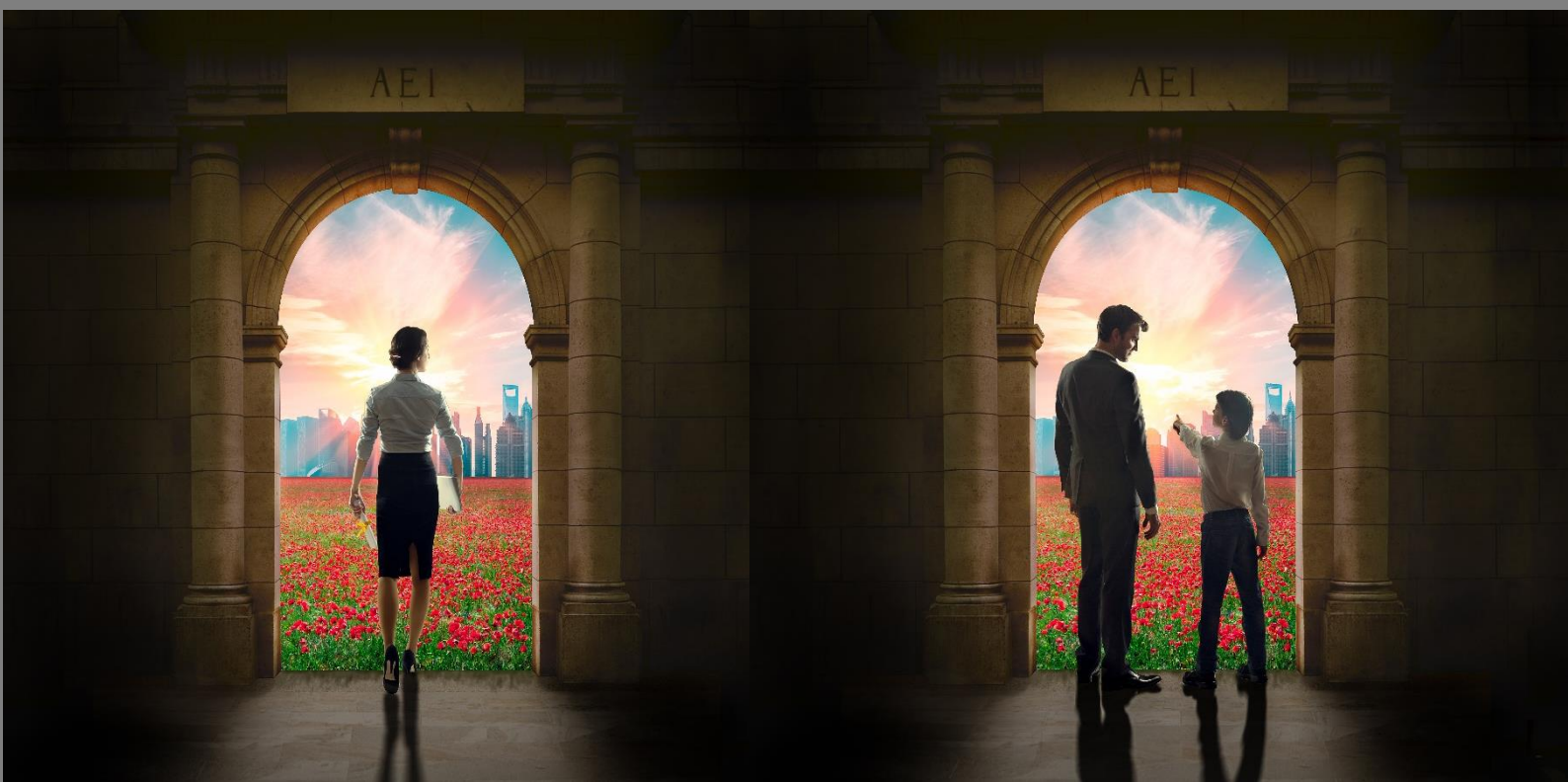

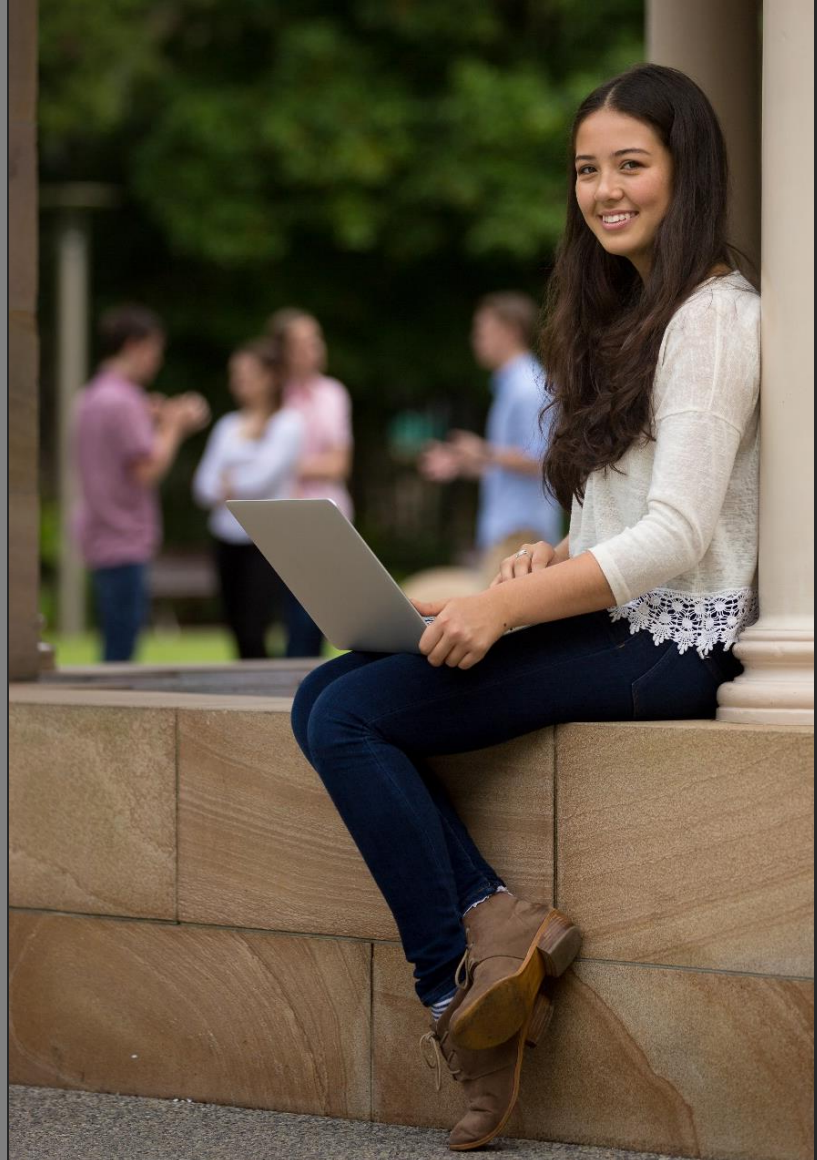

POSITION OVERVIEW

Running alongside its 'Dare To Be Brilliant!' Campaign inspiring students to excel, Alpert Enterprises International provides opportunities for students and professionals to achieve and demonstrate excellence through workshops, competitions, awards, conferences and events.

The Pegasus Student Program is a sector of AEI dedicated solely to giving motivated, high potential students opportunities to develop further and excel in the academic areas they are most passionate about. As part of the program, AEI runs the EXCEL Weekend Workshops for Year 7-10 students twice each term. These weekend workshops are designed for students, who are keen to improve their knowledge and skills in a particular subject area, such as English, Mathematics, or Science. Students are divided into two groups (Years 7-8 & Years 9-10), and participate in a two-day workshop related to one subject area (English, Mathematics, or Science).

Alpert Enterprises International is inviting applications from teachers to join our team of professionals as presenters for the Term 1, EXCEL Weekend Workshops. Workshop presenters are required to deliver a two day workshop for Year 7-8 students or Year 9-10 students in one of the following subject areas: English, Mathematics or Science. Workshop programs and materials will be designed and constructed through collaborative efforts prior to delivery of the student workshops.

- Plan, in collaboration with colleagues, a two day workshop for chosen year levels in one subject area: English, Mathematics, or Science
- Ensure workshop program aligns with existing curriculum
- Ensure workshop program demonstrates creativity and innovative pedagogical strategies
- Submit a workshop program (including workshop summary for marketing purposes)
- Undertake a complementary two hour Professional Development session on working with highly motivated or high ability students, organized by Alpert Enterprises International
- Submit planning materials and workshop materials in a timely manner in order to allow for organisation of logistics by Alpert Enterprises International
- Demonstrate collaborative work practices
- Deliver an exciting, challenging and high quality workshop for chosen year levels in specified subject area

2. Possession of a current Blue Card or Exemption Card (QCT Registered Teachers only)
3. Dedication to cultivating and celebrating excellence
4. Innovation and creativity in pedagogical practices (teaching and learning strategies)
5. Strong knowledge of curriculum in your subject area(s)
6. Experience with teaching middle school (Years 7-10) students
7. Expertise in literacy and/or numeracy coaching
